CARTA Announces Modified Service Schedule Due to Inclement Weather

Temporary Operating Hours and Closures January 24-26

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn. – The Chattanooga Area Regional Transportation Authority (CARTA) is announcing modified operating hours and service closures in preparation for upcoming inclement weather affecting the Chattanooga region this weekend.

The following schedule will be in effect:

Saturday, January 24th: All CARTA fixed route, shuttles, CARTA Go, and CARE-A-VAN services will operate as usual until 5:00 pm.

Sunday, January 25th: All CARTA services will not be operating.

Monday, January 26th: All bus services will resume at 10:00 am, weather permitting. Administrative offices will be closed.

Incline Railway: The Incline Railway will be closed January 24th through 26th.

Customers are encouraged to plan their transportation needs accordingly and allow extra travel time when services resume. CARTA is monitoring weather conditions closely and will provide additional updates if further schedule adjustments become necessary.
